Start planning 1-1,5 years ahead!

WHAT?

Studying, internship, summer school, language course,...

HOW?

Exchange programmes (ERASMUS, TUDworldwide, double degree, faculty cooperations,...) Leonardo-Office, Freemover

WHERE?

Regional preferences, language skills, living expenses

HOW MUCH?

Funding programmes (ERASMUS, PROMOS, DAAD, foundations, AuslandsBAföG, ...)

and costs (tuition fees?), ...

Recognition of academic achievements

- academic advisor or the examination office

Leave of absence

- TUD grants leave of absence for exchange semesters
- A semester for which leave of absence has been granted does not count as a semester spent studying.

Language skills and accepted language certificates

- National language vs. language of instruction
- Required language level varies

- documents: online application form, CV, detailed description of the planned study project and the study objectives), overview of all study achievements with signature and stamp of the Examination Office, language certificate(s), Certificate of enrollment

- University exchange programme of the EU
- TUD: approx. **600 outgoing students** per academic year
- **Erasmus+ programme countries**
 - EU-Member States
 - Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Turkey, North Macedonia, Serbia

- Mobility grant
- Repeated funding possible
- Exemption from tuition fees at the partner university
- Online language courses
- Academic recognition of achievements
- Support (home & partner university)
- Easy online application procedure
- Extra funding (social top-up, funding for sustainable travel, soon: travel allowance)

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- Enrollment at TU Dresden as a full-time student
- Any nationality
- Sufficient knowledge of the language of instruction
- Motivation
- Interest

- Early planning
- [Mobility portal](#): Find a suitable host university:
- Select a smaller university
- Choose a less visited country
- Read [Testimonials](#)
- Improve your language skills
 - Language of instruction/country language: B1 recommended
 - Language certificate at the latest when registering at the host university
- Internet research
- Attend consultation hours (ERASMUS coordinator, International Office....)
- Discuss the recognition of foreign credits



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HOW much funding will I receive?

Mobility allowance = compensation for part of the additional costs during the stay abroad

Payment in 2 installments (70 % at the beginning, 30 % at the end)

Category A (600 €):

Belgium, Denmark, Finland, France, Great Britain, Ireland, Iceland, Italy, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Norway, Austria, Sweden, BERN11

Category B (540 €):

Bulgaria, Estonia, Greece, Croatia, Latvia, Lithuania, Malta, Macedonia, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Serbia, Spain, Czech Republic, Turkey, Hungary, Cyprus

Available additional funding (Social Top Up)

- Green Erasmus
- Students with fewer opportunities

WHAT additional funding is available in Erasmus+?

Students with fewer opportunities + EUR 250 per month (top-up)

- Students with GdB from 20
- Students with a chronic illness
- Students with child/children
- Students from non-academic parents

Employed students (monthly net income between € 450 and € 850, employment for at least 6 months before the start of the stay)

New from summer semester 2026

- **Travel allowance** (scaled according to distance + depending on means of transport)

Green Erasmus

- Extra funding for “green travel” e.g. by train up to max. 6 additional travel days + **higher travel allowance**



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Erasmus – Short Term Mobility?

Blended Short Term Mobility/ Blended Intensive Programmes (BIP)

- Short stays of 5-30 days (physical stay)
- combined with mandatory virtual component
- at least 3 credits

Financial support for physical stay:

Day 5-14: 79 EUR per day

Day 15-30: 56 EUR per day

for students with fewer opportunities: EUR 100 one-off (day 5-14)

for green travel: up to 6 additional days

Travel allowance if applicable (only on application)

- Apply online via the [mobility portal](#)
- Erasmus+ exchange spots of the faculties, institutes or chairs
- Application period: **January - March**
- 1 application - 3 priorities
- Please check deadlines!
- Application for academic year or semester:
WiSe (Aug./Sept – Jan./Feb.)
SuSe (Jan./Feb. – June/July)
- **Vacant exchange spots** will be allocated as long as nomination + registration at host university is possible
- Vacant exchange spots in SoSe 2026:
submit complete application online via [mobility portal](#) by 15.09.2025 at the latest
