## **Accommodation**

### **Host Family program**

Cost: \$400 USD monthly

## Off-Campus accommodation

We do not have residence halls, but we provide a list of options around campus. All arrangements must be handled by the students.

What is included? Please review with the landlords

Cost: Between \$200 and \$500 USD monthly



# Livingexpenses

★ Accommodation	\$200 to \$500 USD per month
★ Meals	\$5 USD per meal (Cafeteria)
★ Transportation (cabs)	\$5 USD per 20 minutes ride in a cab
★ Transportation (public)	\$0.50 USD buses, subway, light train
★ Copies	\$0.10 USD (black and white)
★ School supplies	\$50 USD per course per semester



# **Migration Process**

The migration process is defined by the nationality of the students:

- ★ Free nationalities do not need a visa if they are staying for 180 days or less.
- ★ Restricted nationalities require a visa, regardless of the time of stay.

Everyone coming to Mexico for more than 180 days, needs a visa.
