



Undergraduate Grading System	Academic performance is assessed by the student's attendance and grades in each course. Grades are expressed in values ranging from 0.0 (zero) to 10.0 (ten). In order to pass a course, students must obtain a final average grade equal to or greater than 6.0 (six) and minimum attendance of 75%.
