

Data Protection Declaration on the Processing of Personal Data in the Context of the Application Process for the DAAD Award / Declaration of Consent

For what purpose will personal data be processed?

The "DAAD Award for Outstanding Achievement by International Students at German Universities", endowed with 1,000 EUR, is intended to recognize outstanding international students who have distinguished themselves through remarkable social or intercultural commitment and special academic achievements. The selection of the honored person is made internally at the university.

What is the legal basis for the processing of personal data?

The legal basis for the processing of data for the aforementioned purposes is Art. 6 para. 1 and subpara. 1 letter a and, if applicable, Art. 9 para. 2 letter a GDPR (consent).

What personal data will be processed?

Only the personal data specified in the relevant [application form](#) and in the [certificate issued by the Examination Office](#) will be processed.

How will personal data be processed and how long will it be stored?

If the data is no longer required for the fulfillment of contractual or legal obligations of TU Dresden, it will be deleted regularly (after 5 years at the latest), unless there are legal reasons preventing its deletion.

Will personal data be transferred to third parties?

Unless stipulated otherwise by law or unless you have given your express consent in individual cases, no personal data will be transferred to third parties.

Will personal data be published?

No personal data will be published.

What general rights do data subjects have?

Voluntariness and withdrawal (Art. 7 para. 3 GDPR)

The submission of personal data is voluntary. You can refuse or withdraw your consent at any time without stating a reason to the person responsible for the data. Your personal data will then no longer be processed and will be deleted immediately, unless the achievement of the research objectives would likely be impossible or seriously impaired and there is a legal basis other than

consent for the processing (in particular § 12 para. 1 Saxon Data Protection Implementation Act - SächsDSDG).

Right of access to personal data (Art. 15 GDPR)

You have the right to obtain information on the data processed concerning your person, as well as the potential recipients of this data, at any time. You are entitled to a reply within one month after the responsible party receives the request for your information.

Right to rectification, erasure and restriction (Art. 16-18 GDPR)

You may request TU Dresden to correct or erase your personal data or restrict its processing at any time.

Right to data portability (Art. 20 GDPR)

You may request that the responsible party send you your personal data in a machine-readable form. Alternatively, you can request the direct transfer of your personal data to a different responsible party, insofar as this is possible.

Right to lodge a complaint (Art. 77 GDPR)

You can contact TUD's Data Protection Officer (see above) at any time and, in the case of a complaint pursuant to Art. 77 GDPR, the supervisory authority for data protection.
