



Call for Applications for Georgius Agricola Scholarships

For a Research/Study Stay at TU Dresden

Funded by the Saxon State Ministry of Higher Education, Research and the Arts (funding regulations of December 17, 2004)

Funding is available for **refugee students from Ukraine (with Ukrainian or other citizenship)** who have completed at least one (or, in the case of some third-country nationals, two) year(s) of study at a state-recognized university in Ukraine and want to **study or do research at TU Dresden** (students who have started and not yet completed their studies).

The scholarships offer Ukrainian students the opportunity to conduct a study or research project at TU Dresden as **exchange students (non-degree studies)** with the following purposes:

a) Participation in classes - course descriptions are available at <http://www.tu-dresden.de/sins> → choose a degree program → click " module descriptions" under "content",

b) Realization of research, a study or project work and/or participation in a research project of TU Dresden (supervision by scientists at TU Dresden, the applicant has to contact an academic supervisor at TU Dresden on his/her own initiative).

Exchange students are enrolled at TU Dresden and can officially take exams in individual courses (but cannot obtain a degree). Students who would like to change to a degree program (Bachelor´s, Diplom, Master´s, etc.) at TU Dresden after studying as exchange students (non-degree studies) can find information about language courses, application and scholarships on the following website (also in Ukrainian, Russian and English):

Duration of Scholarship: October 1, 2022 to March 31, 2023 (with option for further funding)

Scholarship: EUR 450/month

Application Requirements:

- Ukrainian citizenship or students from third countries who have already studied in Ukraine until the beginning of the war
 - Bachelor's students with at least one (or, in the case of some third-country nationals, depending on university access, two) year(s) of study, Master's students or doctoral students from a state-recognized higher education institution in Ukraine

- Knowledge of German or English at B1 level

Application Deadline:

September 16, 2022

The letter of admission for non-degree studies at TU Dresden (2022/23 winter semester) may be submitted subsequently until September 30, 2022.

Application documents:

1. Georgius Agricola Scholarship application form (German or English version)
2. Letter of admission for non-degree studies at TU Dresden (2022/23 winter semester)

3. Copy of passport (1st page with name, date of birth, place of birth, date of expiration)

The application documents have to be sent exclusively **in digital form (PDF documents, max. 10 MB)** with the **subject "Application G.-Agricola Scholarship"** to the following e-mail address:

We recommend **sending your application documents in encrypted form**, but encryption is not mandatory. Then you can send your application documents as an attachment to the above-mentioned e-mail address via TU Dresden's SecureMail portal.
