



Job ticket at the TU Dresden

Information about the job ticket

What's the job ticket?

The VVO job ticket has been available for TU employees since 2012. The VVO and the Free State of Saxony each subsidise the ticket with 10%.

What are the requirements?

1. The applicant should be an employee of the Free State of Saxony: The term "employee" includes all persons who are in an active employment, work or training relationship with the Free State of Saxony, in particular civil servants, judges, employees covered by collective bargaining agreements, aspirants, trainees, etc.
2. The applicant grants the VVO a direct debit authorisation to debit the monthly job ticket amounts from the private account.

What does the job ticket cost?

In addition, there is an annual service fee of currently EUR 9.90 for the services and logistics required to process the job ticket.

How do I apply for a job ticket?

Applications (please do not forget your declaration of data protection/consent!) can be submitted on the first day of each month and can be submitted up to the 3rd working day of the previous month to Unit 2.1 University lecturers/officials (Personnel Department), Strehleener Str. 22/24, Zi. 367 (Ms Celesti, Tel.: 40368). Once the details have been completed by the office, the application will be submitted directly to DVB by the office, which will then make it possible to start work on the first day of the next month. The application and data protection/declaration of consent can also be completed in full and submitted at least four weeks in advance to the Customer Centre of Dresdner Verkehrsbetriebe AG at Postplatz 1, 01067 Dresden. The confirmation by the office must then be received in good time in advance by Ms Celesti, Strehleener Str. 22/24, Room 367.



How can I switch from an monthly abo/subscription or annual pass to a job ticket?

Due to the associated card exchange, it is only possible to change from an monthly abo/subscription or annual ticket directly at the service point. The application forms and data protection/consent declaration are the same.

Is the job ticket transferable?

The VVO job ticket is valid from Monday to Friday from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. only in conjunction with an identity document (personal) and is not transferable during this period. The VVO job ticket can be transferred all day Monday to Friday from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. as well as on Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays.

The reduced VVO job ticket (e.g. for trainees) is not transferable.

Who or what can I take with me?

The job ticket can be used as a family day ticket (maximum two adults and maximum four pupils until the 15th birthday) within its area of validity from Monday to Friday from 6 p.m. to 4 a.m. of the following day. On weekends and public holidays, this rule applies all day. Please take note of the validity and take-away regulations for family day tickets. Job ticket users can take a bicycle or a dog with them free of charge within the area of validity.

SZ Bike

With the job ticket you can register with SZ Bike free of charge and rent a bike for short rides under the appropriate conditions. As owner of a job ticket, you have the first 30 minutes of a ride free: <https://www.dvb.de/de-de/service/mietfahrraeder/>
