

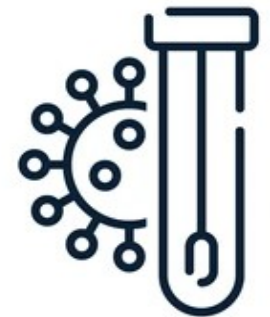

Occupational health and safety instruction: Supervision of antigen self-tests (SARS-CoV-2)

December 2021

Supervised antigen self-tests

- **Important: The persons testing themselves are potentially infectious, so be sure to protect yourself!**
 - Wear an **FFP-2 mask** during supervision.
 - Keep **at least 1.50 m distance** to the person being tested.
 - Avoid any contact with the used test materials.
 - **Ventilate** the room during and after the test procedure.
- Monitor the correct application of the self-test (see e.g. <https://www.bundesregierung.de/breg-de/mediathek/video-selbsttests-1873982>), give advice in case of incorrect conduct.
- **Follow-up:** Have the test materials disposed in a garbage bag by the tested person and have it securely closed (e.g. knot). Afterwards, have the table thoroughly disinfected.

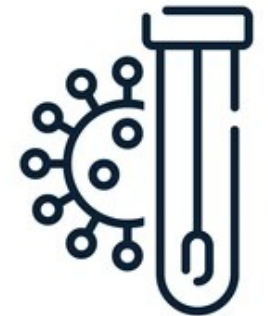
Supervised antigen self-tests

If the **test result is positive**:

- Request that the tested persons gets **PCR tested** and that they go into isolation.
- **Report** the test result to the **health department**.
- Observe **process flow** for cases of infection.
