## **Election Announcement - University Elections 2020**

On the basis of the Act on the Autonomy of Institutions of Higher Education in the Free State of Saxony (*SächsHSFG*) in the currently valid version from December 10, 2008, the currently valid version of the Basic Rules of TU Dresden from September 24, 2015 as well as the currently valid version of the Election Regulations of TU Dresden from September 27, 2019 in connection with the Special Election Regulations of TU Dresden from July 14, 2020, the following positions are advertised:

## Active and Passive Voting Rights

Active voting rights (eligibility to vote) and passive voting rights (eligibility to stand for election) can only be exercised by persons who are entered in the electoral register. All persons entitled to vote can only vote and be elected in one group and in their School, faculty, or Central Unit. The Equal Opportunity Officers as well as their deputies are elected by all members of the faculty, School or Central Unit. Representatives of all groups of the respective faculty, School, or Central Unit may be elected as Equal Opportunity Officers or their deputies. Members belonging to more than one group may, until the closure of the electoral register, make a statement as to which group they wish to exercise their voting rights in. If a statement is not given, eligibility to vote is determined by the order of the groups listed in § 50 para. 1 Act on the Autonomy of Institutions of Higher Education in the Free State of Saxony (SächsHSFG). Eligibility to vote can only be determined uniformly for all the elections mentioned.

## Electoral Register

Between November 6 and 13, 2020, and in the time between 9:00 am and 4:00 pm, the Electoral Register can be viewed in the Electoral Office, Mommsenstraße 15, Room 6-220, Tel. +49 351 463 37068. Non-registration or incorrect registration can be appealed against in writing or by digitally signed email (request for amendment) to the Election Officer until the Electoral Register is closed on November 13, 2020, 4:00 pm (§ 5 of the Electoral Regulations).

## Election Proposals

Only those who have been included in a valid election proposal can be elected. Proposals must be submitted in writing to the Election Officer between October 30 and November 13, 2020. An election proposal must contain the first and last name and, for members of staff, the official title of the candidate, including their organisational unit. For student election proposals, the first and last name must be included, as well as the student body, the degree program, the semester and, for teacher-training programs, the combination of subjects of the candidate (§ 8 of the Election Regulations). The deadline for submission is November 13, 2020, at 4:00 pm. Any proposals submitted after the deadline will not be considered. The valid proposals will be announced in a circular letter and under the following link:

## Election Notification

Those eligible to vote will not receive any special election notification.

## Postal Vote

In accordance with § 10 of the Special Election Regulations, the elections shall take place **exclusively by postal vote**.

Voting at a ballot box shall not take place (§ 10 of the Special Election Regulations). From the time of the announcement of this election, the documents for the postal vote can be applied for exclusively via the electronic application form of the ZIH under the following link (§ 10 of the Special Election Regulations):

You can request to have the postal vote documents sent to you by submitting the application by November 18, 2020, or by December 3, 2020 if it is to be collected in person.

## Voting

The postal votes of those entitled to vote must have been received by the Election Officer or been handed in at the Election Office by 4:00 pm on December 10, 2020 at the latest.

## Announcement of the Election Results

The public counting of votes shall take place immediately following the voting period at the Election Office or at the Election Office of the voting rooms. The election results will be sent to the Election Committee by the Chairperson of the Election Board. The preliminary election result will be subsequently determined and published on the pages of TU Dresden under:
