## **Excerpt from "Concept for Honorary Awards of TU Dresden"**

### ı. Criteria for choosing specific form of award - Badge of Honor

Members of TU Dresden who have rendered outstanding services that are especially beneficial to the university and deserving of special recognition can be awarded a Badge of Honor. These can be outstanding individual achievements or a special commitment. These exceptional services can relate to strategic goals of TU Dresden, ideas in science, teaching, knowledge and technology transfer, administration as well as academic self-administration. Whether these achievements are known to the public or only within the university, what is important is that they contribute to its further development. The outstanding services rendered must, by definition, be above and beyond the individual's general duty or prescribed role. How outstanding this service is needs to be assessed in each individual case, especially in relation to the role of the respective member group. Diversity in terms of member groups, gender and topics are further criteria contributing to the decision to award the honor. The award is not intended to recognize an achievement in terms of years of service. Compared to the Medal of Honor, the criteria for awarding the Badge of Honor are less stringent. In principle, it is also possible to honor groups or teams with the Badge of Honor. The Badge of Honor rounds off the spectrum of honorary awards at TU Dresden.

## **II. Bestowing awards**

A "Badge of Honor" Commission of the University Executive Board shall be formed annually to select the nominees for this award. The Commission is chaired by the Rector and composed of one representative of each of the four member groups of TU Dresden as well as one further member of the University Executive Board. The representatives of the four member groups shall be delegated by the voting senators of the respective member group and shall consult with their member groups. After screening the submissions, the Badge of Honor Commission of the University Executive Board internally and confidentially draws up a list of a maximum of eight nominees. The vote in the Senate shall consider the list as a whole. The Senate shall decide on the awarding of all honors after approval by the University Executive Board by a 3/4 majority of the voting members present.
