For what purpose will personal data be processed?

What is the legal basis for the processing of personal data?

The legal basis for the processing of data for the aforementioned purposes is Art. 6 para. 1 letter b GDPR.

Which personal data will be processed? How will it be processed? For how long will it be stored, and will it be transferred to third parties?

For the evaluation of the abridged report or the evaluation of the program, only the personal data specified in the abridged report will be processed. The data will be deleted after the purpose ceases to apply, but no later than 12 months after the end of the evaluation of the abridged reports. Due to budgetary regulations, data that is necessary for the proper proof of the use of funds at TU Dresden is stored for a period of 10 years.

Unless stipulated otherwise by law or unless you have given your express consent in individual cases, no personal data will be transferred to third parties.

Which are the general rights of data subjects?

To claim your rights, it is sufficient to notify the responsible person in writing (email or letter).

You have the right to obtain information on the data processed concerning your person, as well as the possible recipients of this data, at any time. You may, at any time, request that TU Dresden rectifies or erases your personal data or restricts processing.

In addition, you have the right to complain to the responsible supervisory authority for data protection. The responsible supervisory authority is the Saxon Data Protection Officer - *Sächsischer Datenschutzbeauftragter*, Devrientstraße 5, 01067 Dresden, www.datenschutz.sachsen.de.
