# The Center for Teacher Education and Educational Research (ZLSB)

The Center for Teacher Education and Educational Research (ZLSB) was founded in 2005 as a central academic institution of Technische Universität Dresden. The center, which operates across faculties, coordinates teacher education study programmes at TU Dresden, supervises students in the Academic Affairs Office for Teacher Training, contributes to advanced teacher training and initiates research and development projects.

The ZLSB contributes to the ,Quality offensive in teacher education' launched by the Federal and State governments with its project ,TUD-Sylber - Synergetic Teacher Education'. The project ,IMPRESS', funded by the DAAD, aims to internationalise teacher training at the university. The EC funded project ,TAP-TS' aims to strengthen school teachers' competences for teaching sustainability. The project ,TUD-MTC' provides support to students towards successfully completing their studies, with backing from the Free State of Saxony. In addition to fundamental teacher training courses, the ZLSB assists the Free State of Saxony in providing professional and scientific training to prospective teachers from other fields within the project ,BQL - second-career-teacher program'.

A board, supported by a head office, runs the Center. The participation of the relevant faculties and status groups is

coordinated by the Academic Council, as well as working groups focused on the promotion of didactic innovation in education and research, internships, further training options for teaching staff, inclusion and digitalisation, and vocational education. In addition to representatives of the university, the members of the working groups include representatives of the second phase of teacher training and the educational authorities. The students have their own central representation at the center.

TU Dresden offers initial teacher education for primary schools ("Grundschule"), secondary schools ("Oberschule", "Gymnasium") and vocational schools ("Berufsbildende Schulen"). These study programmes are run by 10 faculties in 4 fields, comprising 20 subjects and 10 professional fields. In addition, all TU Dresden departments offer classes in the teacher education study programmes.

#### **Management and Head Office**

The head office including a general manager supports the ZLSB board and organises as well as coordinates the execution of the Center's responsibilities. Together, the board and the general manager represent the Center in teacher education networks, cross-institutional working groups and joint international projects.
